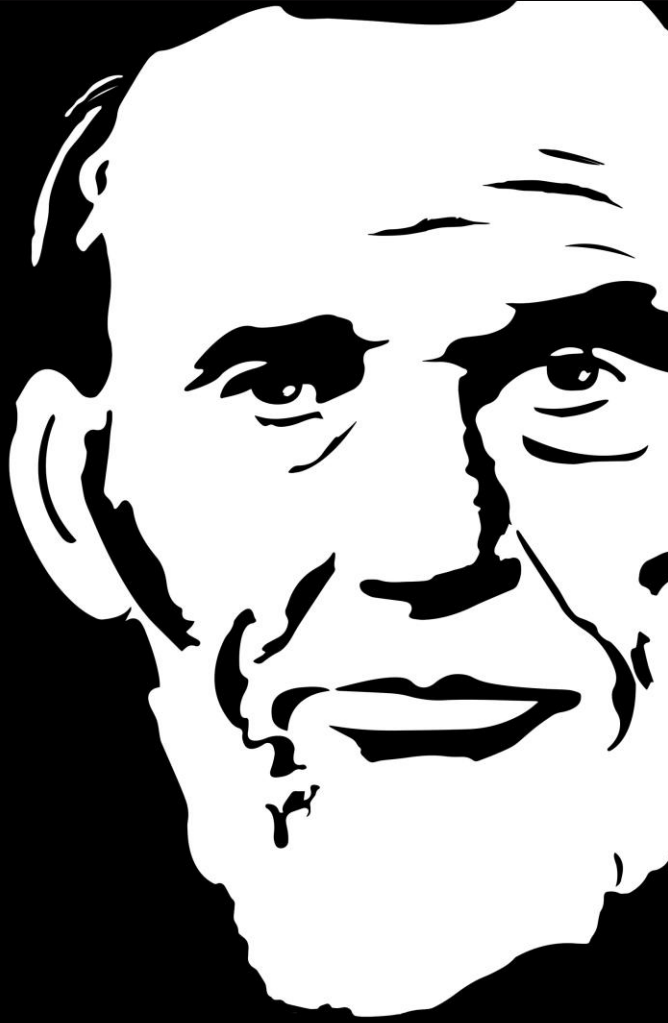

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Please review your enrollment/re-enrollment packets for more detailed information. You may also contact your grade-level parent and/or Bridges ambassador for questions that are not covered here. Another resource is the official Bridges Student-Parent Handbook, which can be found on the school's website at www.bridges.edu/bridges-student-parent-handbook.

Who can answer general questions about the campus and school procedures?

Grade-Level Parents – Like room parents at other schools, these are the people who will keep you up-to-date about what is happening in your division and/or grade (*see page 3*).

Ambassadors – These are parents of Bridges students or graduates who assist new families in getting settled.

Your PA co-presidents, vice president, and co-secretaries also are available to help answer questions. If they don't know the answer, they will know the direction in which to point you!

Faculty and staff names, photos, titles, and contact information are listed on the Bridges website at www.bridges.edu/faculty--staff.

Where do I find the school roster?

The link to our roster is located on the "Community" page of the Bridges website at www.bridges.edu/community. Contact the PA leadership for the password. The roster is confidential. Please do not share this roster or the password outside the Bridges community. Thank you.

What are the hours for school arrival and dismissal?

The first bell rings at 8:30 a.m. signaling to students that it is time to go to class. Students arriving before 8:30 a.m. are to wait outside near the main entrance unless they have permission to enter the building before school. Classes start at 8:35 a.m. every day. Monday through Thursday, Phoenix dismissal is 3:00 p.m. and dismissal for middle and high school is at 3:50 p.m. Every Friday is a shortened day for all students with school ending at 2:15 p.m. Hours occasionally are shortened for student conferences or other reasons. Please pay close attention to the weekly email newsletter and check the Bridges calendar at: www.bridges.edu/calendar.

How do I find a carpool?

Many parents form carpools with other Bridges families who live or work close to them. This is done on an informal basis using the Bridges zip code list, available at the end of the roster (*to access the roster see page 12*). You also can ask your grade-level parent (*see page 3*) or Bridges ambassador if they are aware of existing carpools in your area.

Where do I drop off and pick up my child?

Morning drop-off is the same for all students: Drive onto campus using the main entrance, make your first right, follow the line of cars past the Phoenix/Administrative building (on your left) and the gym (on your right). Pull as far forward as possible into or past the breezeway (the covered portion between the gym and main entrance to the middle/high school building). Our school security officer's name is Lorenzo Yzaguirre - please follow all his safety instructions.

After-school pick-up for Phoenix and middle school is in the same breezeway area. After school pick-up for high school is located in the roundabout at the far end of the parking lot.
